











# **Project History – Planning Documents**

## **Project Overview**

- Previously conducted Public Outreach
- Environmental Review Process
  - Prepare Environmental Impact Report (EIR)
  - City Council select Preferred Alternative for the EIR
  - Re-issue Notice of Preparation (NOP)
  - All proposed alternatives will be studied in the EIR
- Prepare Draft EIR/Final EIR
- City Council approve the EIR & select a Project Alternative
- Begin Detailed Design for the Project Alternative (separate project in the future)












# **Proposed Project Schedule**

# **Example of a Cycle Track**















### **Alternative 1 – Four Lanes with Cycle Track and Sidewalks**



### **Alternative 2 – Two Lanes with Cycle Track and Sidewalks**















# Alternative 3 – HOV/Transit/Shuttle with Cycle Track and Sidewalks



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


