

- Lifeguards have full authority and may enforce rules not listed as situations warrant
- Everyone who enters the pool facility must pay admission, including guests that are not swimming
- Always walk on the pool deck
- Life vests must be Coast Guard approved and only permitted in the shallow areas of the pool
- Pool toys are at the discretion of the lifeguards based on safety concerns
- **DO NOT SWIM** if you have a contagious/communicable disease, bandage, open wound, blister or sore
- Lifeguards have the discretion at any time to limit an activity or call for swim breaks

## WHEN ENTERING THE POOL

- Everyone must shower before entering the pool
- Wear proper swim attire in the pool
- Infants and toddlers must wear swim diapers under their swimsuits
- Adults must be IN THE WATER with children under the age of 6
- Adults must be in the pool area with children under the age of 12
- Children under the age of 13 must pass a swim test to enter the deep end
- Large groups must have one adult **IN THE WATER** for every 10 children

## **NOT PERMITTED**

- Diving
- Fighting, roughhousing, chicken fighting, screaming and profanity
- Unsafe swimming behavior, including pretending to drown or holding your breath for long periods of time
- Food, drinks, glass, sharp objects, tobacco and marijuana
- Animals, except for service animals
- Water wings, inner tubes, kickboards and pool noodles
- Scuba masks, snorkels and swim fins
- Jeans or T-shirts in the pool
- Swimming without a lifeguard on duty
- Water guns

FAILURE TO FOLLOW RULES will result in a loss of swim privileges. This includes exiting the facility without a refund or denied future entrance.
