

Before you start:

- To apply for a permit, you need to create an account.
- For most permits, you will need to upload documents. These documents must be PDFs.
- Enter information using proper capitalization for names or street addresses. Examples: Olive Avenue, Jane Smith
- Enter detailed project descriptions.
- You must use a credit card to make payments online. Payments are secure and credit card numbers are not stored by the City.
- If your project is in the Public Right of Way or doesn't have a specific address or APN number, call the One Stop Permit Center. You may not be able to apply online.
- If you think your building project might need Planning review first, email planning@sunnyvale.ca.gov.
- Visit Sunnyvale.ca.gov/PermitCenter to find any required forms for your permit.
