RECYCLED WATER FILL STATION PROGRAM

To help conserve drinking water, the City of Sunnyvale's **Recycled Water Fill Station Program** is offering clean, safe, tertiary-treated recycled water to commercial customers at an affordable rate. This program is not currently available for residential purposes.

Commercial customers can fill-up their tanks from a hydrant conveniently located at the Sunnyvale Water Pollution Control Plant. Recycled water obtained under this program can be used for construction and other nonpotable purposes, such as dust control, soil compaction, and sewer flushing.

Before tanks can be filled for the first time, customers are required to submit a permit application and attend a brief training in order to learn about using the filling station and the proper handling and use of recycled water. Vehicles being used for transporting recycled water to job sites are also required to pass an inspection. Customers will be charged the current utility service rate for recycled water.

Requirements for obtaining and using recycled water under this program can be found on the back of this flyer and in the Recycled Water Design and Construction Standards.

FILL STATION GUIDELINES AND USE REQUIREMENTS

- 1) Sign-in at the Front Desk Lobby
- 2) Show your permit and driver license
- 3) Make sure your recycled water signs are in the proper location on your vehicle
- Proceed to the fill station where an Operator will assist the fill process by unlocking the hydrant valve
- 5) Sign-out at the Front Desk Lobby
- Use recycled water in accordance with the use(s) specified on your permit within the Sunnyvale Service Area

Please remember to...

- Bring your own hose for the hydrant
- Turn off your vehicle during the fill process
- Do not litter or block the roadway
- Keep your permit in your vehicle at all times

Do

Wash hands with potable water after working with recycled water

Use as soon as possible after filling

Equip vehicles with water-tight valves and fittings

Disinfect tank before filling with potable water

Do Not

Drink recycled water Use for washing hands or food Allow to enter into eating areas Spray onto drinking water fountains Allow overspray, ponding, or run off Use in any permanent piping system Use outside Sunnyvale Service Area
